Seacoast is industry agnostic and typically invests \$5MM to \$30MM+ of capital in companies with \$10MM+ of revenue and \$2MM+ of EBITDA. Our capital is generally used to support any combination of growth, recapitalizations, acquisitions, management buyouts, shareholder repurchases and dividend recapitalizations. Since inception, Seacoast has managed over \$1B of capital. Now investing our fifth fund, we continue to actively seek new investment opportunities.
